Below are things you can find in Torak and Wolf's wild world. Have you seen any of these before? See how many of these you can find on your next nature walk.



Pinecones

Grow on evergreen pines.

Protect the pine tree seeds.

Drop from the trees every year to help grow new pines.



Grow on bramble bushes.

They are a fruit and turn purple when ripe. They are easy to find as summer turns to autumn.





Mushrooms

Unlike most plants, mushrooms don't need sunlight to grow.

They are made up of 90% water.

Some are deadly and poisonous.





Acorns

Grow on oak trees.

They are a type of nut.

Squirrels, woodpeckers, boars and bears all eat them.



Sycamore trees can live for 400 years.

They are known for their wing-like seeds. When they fall to the ground they spin as if they are flying.




Holly




























Stone Age Animal Trumps

Challenge your friend to a game of top trumps! Colour in and cut out the cards.



How to play:

To begin the game, shuffle the cards and deal them to each player face down.

One player starts by looking at their top card and reading out a category. For e.g. 'Height 1.5m'. The other player then reads out the same category from their top card.

The player with the highest value wins the round. That player collects the cards from that round and adds them back into their hand at the bottom of the pile.

The player who wins the round goes next. It is their turn to choose a statistic from the next card.

If a category is called out and both players have the same number, the cards are put in the middle. Whoever wins the next round collects the cards in the middle. When one player holds all the cards, they win and the game is over.

Mammoth True or False Answers

False - There are lots of different types of mammoth: Woolly Mammoth, Columbian Mammoth, Imperial Mammoth and many more.

True - Mammoths didn't eat meat, they ate plants, mushrooms, bushes, willows and grass.

True - Mammoths lived for 60–80 years.


False - A small number of mammoths lived on Wrangel Island in the Arctic until about I 650BC; that's only 4,000 years ago.
